Frequently Asked Questions						
Q: What about pickup hockey for minors or Ringette?						
A: They are all considered Class 2 sports as long as they are non-contact. See the Sports and Recreation Activities Plus Camps rating sheet.						
Q: What about sledge hockey?						
A: Sledge hockey is charged at the same rate as the Adult Hockey League.						
Q: How do you define a League?						
A: A league is organized with set teams, scheduled games, standings and it often has paid referees.						
Q: How many players can be on one team?						
A: Up to 30 players. Occasional spares can be included in the coverage as long as a record is maintained of who played, when, where, etc.						
Q: What is Pickup hockey?						
A: Pickup hockey is loosely organized and the players who show up can change from game to game. It is more recreational than hockey league play. It is also known as 'Shinny'						
Q: What about, coaches, managers, etc? Are they covered?						
A: Volunteers, managers, coaches, trainers, executives, etc are covered while acting within the scope of their duties and are not counted in the maximum number of players.
